Position Title: Playground supervisor / Support Team

Camp Location: Lewisham, Greenwich, Southwark, Lambeth

Department: Holiday Camp

Contract: Seasonal volunteering position available in school holidays (Easter, Summer and Christmas).

Shifts and Schedules: Monday to Friday / Part-time – Full-time

Aim of Role

Playground supervisor / Support Team will assist and aid the Hub Leader, coordinators, sport coaches with daily camp activities. These duties will be performed while carrying out the UK Latin Community values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility.

Role Requirements

- Have a desire to work with and care for children
- Be willing to work in a team atmosphere
- Arrive to camp by scheduled time each day
- Return all supplies and equipment to the proper storage area and help to maintain all areas clean at all times
- Eat lunch with your group
- Adhere to schedules and planned activities of the camp
- Do not sit down during an activity, unless the activity is a sit-down activity!
- Prepare for activities before the activity begins
- Notify your Hub Leader or coordinator of ALL incidents immediately, and any discipline problems, as needed.
- Attend all mandatory trainings - online and in person
- Maintain safety, both physically and emotionally, at all times
- Assist in providing an environment where children can be creative, learn new and various activities, and grow as a social being
- Maintain a professional relationship with all staff members and peers while at the UK Latin Community Camp Site
- Communicate to Central Office if you feel the Hub Leader is putting them in a compromising position
- Participate in the planning and implementation of camp programming
- Provide leadership and participate in camp activities, sharing enthusiasm for each activity
- Committing to and upholding all camp rules
- Set a good example
